services, completely blocks general Internet traffic and is limited to the essential functions of your applications.

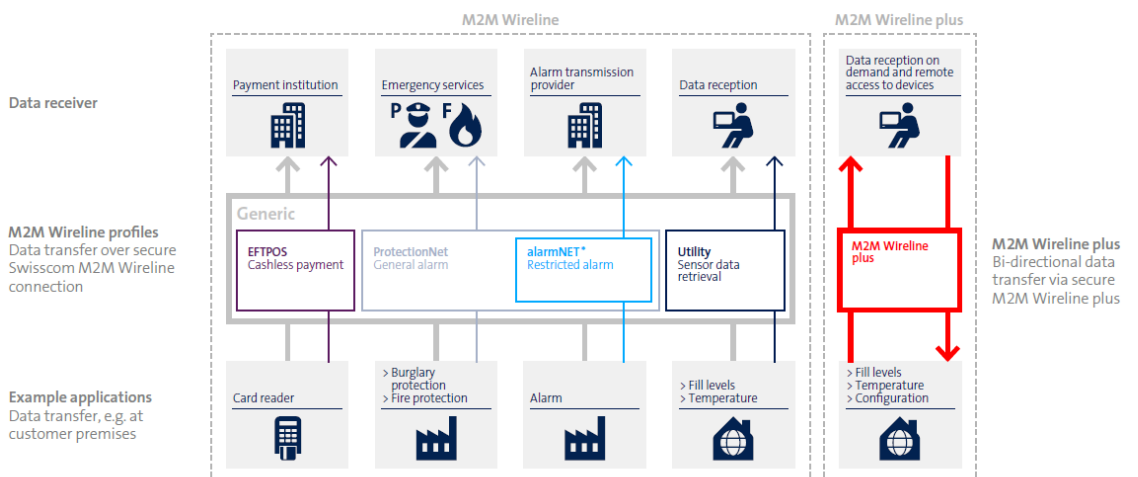
Secure and flexible
