Digitalising customer invoicing processes: reduce costs and automate processing with the E-Invoicing service Switzerland and International

E-Invoicing – the electronic VAT-compliant invoicing process – is aimed at companies that would like to take advantage of a paperless invoicing process.

E-Invoicing can also be combined with the electronic ordering process in order to realise an end-to-end electronic procurement and invoicing process (Procure2Pay/Order2Cash).

Conextrade offers the E-Invoicing service for Switzerland and internationally.

E-Invoicing Switzerland:

If necessary, the data the invoicing party supplies Conextrade with is converted to the recipient's format and signed digitally. This means that the invoicing party does not need to integrate a signature component into their own system. The invoice is dispatched electronically to the invoice recipient along with all relevant attachments such as PDF files or logs. E-Invoicing supports invoices with or without an order reference and fulfills all legal specifications and requirements.

When it arrives at the invoice recipient, the invoice is processed further in the merchandise management system or financing/accounting system and stored in the archive. The signed invoice is considered an invoice document for input tax deduction purposes and legal archiving requirements. The invoicing party obtains the signed invoice documents periodically from Conextrade for archiving.

If the invoicing party and/or invoice recipient does not wish to carry out the archiving himself, Conextrade offers optional long-term archiving for invoices within Switzerland and internationally.

E-Invoicing International:

Technologies and processes are important for a cross-border electronic invoicing process, as are country-specific legal aspects. E-Invoicing International makes use of technologies and processes that fulfill all country-specific requirements.

To ensure that invoicing parties and invoice recipients enjoy legal certainty for the processes and technologies applied within the VAT-compliant invoice exchange, Conextrade draws up the required compliance documents and adapts them continuously to legal changes to ensure that compliance is maintained. Compliance support is currently provided for more than 50 countries.
