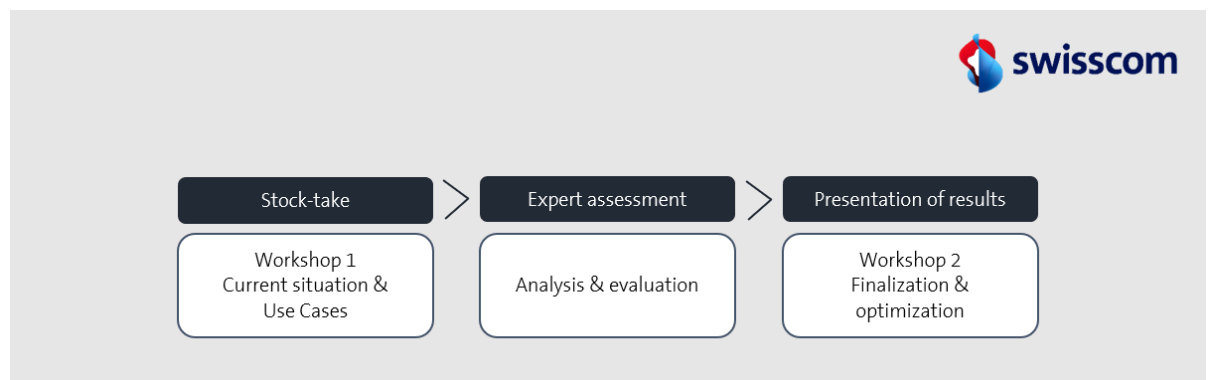

Basic assessment process

Stock-take

We examine your current situation and business requirements, and define use cases and the scope of the assessment together.

Expert assessment

Swisscom conducts a rough assessment of your current situation based on 1-2 core system landscapes and discusses your requirements and use cases with the experts.

The concept is then devised on the basis of the data collected during the stock-take.

Presentation of results

Presentation of Swisscom's expert evaluation:

- Principles of SAP on Azure
- Presentation of the possibilities and versions of SAP on Azure incl. possible SLAs
- Management of the SAP on Azure systems
- Rough analysis of current landscape
- Presentation of 1-2 versions based on 1-2 core system landscapes, e.g. ERP/BW
- Rough cost estimate for the 2 core landscapes

- Migration of current landscape to Microsoft Azure
